

Bob Hahn



Bob Hahn was an active member of the Robson Ranch Photo Club for several years, rarely missing a meeting or workshop. In 2019 he suffered several serious health issues and spent several months in the hospital. Upon his release, in a desire to be more active with the Club, he volunteered to fill an opening on the Board. As a member of the Board, Bob did not bring a vast technical wealth of post-processing techniques nor a deep knowledge of color theory or composition. What he did bring was an unlimited pleasure of seeing other members photos and sharing conversations with them about their images and experiences. Those conversations were always a central theme for Bob—he was a "people person." Bob loved photography and the Club where he always championed the inclusion or addition of any activities that would attract the participation by more members more often. Bob always challenged us to improve the website, and keep it more current!

Bob's health began failing again late last year and, rather than not be contributive, he resigned his Board position to yield to another member. Those conversations and his friendship to the Club however, never did end. He will be missed.
